

Flooring Job Description

Description of Position:

Flooring employees shall prep or remove old coatings from floors by use of Blast Track Machines, HTC Grinders, Buffer Sanders and Hand Grinders. Flooring employees will also reapply coatings with squeegee and rollers or trowel down methods such as ¼ inch overlayment or U-crete materials.

Requirements of Postion:

In order to perform the duties of this position, the following skills and abilities are required:

1. The ability to stand and operate necessary machinery for long periods of time.
2. The ability to work on knees while hand grinding or applying materials for long periods of time. The ability to repeatedly move and/or carry flooring materials on a daily basis.
3. The ability to walk on spikes while squeegeing or back rolling flooring materials.
4. The ability to work in a variety of physical positions including stooping, overhead, squatting, kneeling, twisting, bending stretching, crawling and various movements for up to 12 hours per shift during the week, weekend, or holidays, in-town or out-of-town for an unlimited amount of time. Extensive use of arms and shoulders, gripping and safe use of hand trowels and power trowels.
6. The extensive use of arms and shoulders, gripping and safe use of small and large hand power tools.
7. The ability to perform basic math functions and follow written and/or verbal instructions and safety rules.

The foregoing description of duties for the above position and the abilities required to perform these duties is intended to be representative but is by no means an exhaustive listing of such duties and abilities.
